“How & Why” Nancy will share over 30 quilts, wall hangings, garments and bags. Many have been published and have been finalists and won ribbons in major shows in Paducah, Houston, Santa Clara, Ontario and Japan. In April, 2006 her wall hanging “Infinity” won Best Wall Hanging from the American Quilters Society and is now owned by the Museum in Paducah, Kentucky.

Workshop: “Sashiko”. Learn to hand embroider the beautiful stitching patterns used in Japan. Sashiko is a technique that was used to repair garments in Japan since the 17<sup>th</sup> Century. You will trace various patterns to your wall hanging top and stitch several designs. The simple running stitch becomes complex as these stylized designs from nature form dynamic geometric patterns.
