



It is the mission of this national organization to provide love, a sense of security, warmth and comfort to children who are seriously ill, traumatized, or otherwise in need through the gifts of new, handmade blankets and afghans, lovingly created by volunteer “blanketeers.”

Blankets must be new, handmade and washable. You don’t have to be an expert to create a blanket that is beautiful to a child. Project Linus donates quilts to children of all ages from infants through teens so most sizes will work. Standard sizes are:

- Neo-natal 24x26
- Baby 36x38
- Child 38x48
- Teen 40x60.

Larger blankets work well for all ages.

Any simple pattern done in cheerful 100% cotton fabrics will work well. Leftover blocks and class projects finished to size are great.

Project Linus quilts should be free of pet hair, smoke, sizing and perfumed products including scented detergents and conditioners.

Finished quilts may be turned in to Project Linus at any Canyon Quilters meeting. Please attach a tag with the names of all who worked on the quilt and the finished size.
