Each year Canyon Quilters donates beautiful finished quilts to Veterans organizations. Some will be given to the women in the assisted living unit at the Chula Vista Veterans Home and some will be distributed to the hospice unit at the Veterans Hospital in La Jolla.

The best quilt size for those being given to the veterans at the VA Hospital is 44 x 72. This becomes the “topper” for the veteran’s bed or is a good size to wrap around their shoulders.

Any simple pattern done in cheerful 100% cotton fabrics will work well. The main thing is to say “Thank You” and make someone smile.
